Dear Families and Friends of Willow Creek Ranch,

Willow Creek Ranch Therapeutic Riding Center (WCR) is a nonprofit organization that serves special needs children and adults through riding and learning about horses. The enclosed brochure describes the WCR history and mission of our organization and how riding can help a variety of disorders (like autism, cerebral palsy, Down Syndrome, brain injury) by improving balance, muscle strength, motor skills, concentration and self-confidence.

On Saturday, August 15, 2015, WCR is having a fundraising rodeo, where our riders will have a chance to show off their skills to family and friends. This event will be an opportunity for our family of supporters to help us raise funds for a major improvement in the ability of WCR to provide on-going safety and consistency for our special riders.

Currently, we are at the mercy of our wonderful Wisconsin weather. Late cancellations of lessons because of rainstorms, cold weather, or the hot sun can be confusing to children with special needs, as most look forward to the routine and consistent activities in their life.

Our goal is to raise \$250,000 to build an indoor arena with a parent/visitor viewing area; tack room; handicapped accessible restroom; multi-purpose room for vocational therapy, training and meetings; and horse stalls. In addition, the funds will be used for dust-reduced arena footing, electrical/lighting, plumbing and a handicapped area parking lot.

We are asking all riders, families, and volunteers to participate in our fundraising efforts. There are many ways to help...

Hi, I am Addie and I am 8 years old. I was born 10 weeks early and weighed 2½ pounds. I have cerebral palsy, which means that my left side doesn't work the way it is supposed to and has a hard time keeping up with what I want it to do. I first started riding at Willow Creek Ranch when I was 3 years old and I had a hard time even walking through the sand in the arena to get on my horse. Now, my balance and strength are much better and I don't need side walkers anymore. My goal is to trot on my own by the end of the summer. I love being independent and horseback riding gives me that and makes me feel good about myself. I always bring an apple for my horse as a treat for working hard. I can't imagine my life without the ranch in it. When I get older I want to have a ranch with 10 horses on it and 10 kids with lots of animals!



Hello, my name is Kylie, I am 12 years old and I have been a rider at Willow Creek Ranch since I was 5. I have Tuberos Sclerosis Complex (TSC) and it has caused many difficulties in my life. TSC is when benign tumors grow on different organs of the nervous system. I have 3 different types of tumors in my brain, some on my kidneys and skin. I have lots of seizures and have to be on lots of medications to help me.



Even though I am 12 years old it is hard for me to do things that many other kids my age can do. Willow Creek Ranch has given me the opportunity to do something super special ...I can ride a horse! I can balance, steer, stop, start, and take care of my horse. I have learned to be independent, responsible, and most of all, this program has given me confidence. I am excited about the opportunity to have an indoor arena so I can ride year round. I am so happy to be a part of the Willow Creek Ranch family. A place where miracles happen! Where I can learn, where I am accepted and where I am loved.

My name is Ashley and I am 19 years old. I was diagnosed with Pervasive Developmental Disorder-NOS, which is a form of autism. My major issue is a fear of stairs, hills, and heights. When I go to Willow Creek Ranch my body calms down instantly because my horse Dell is calm with me. Right away, I forget my stress of the day when I arrive at the Ranch and my fear of heights goes away.

I have been riding since 6th grade. My confidence, balance, and coordination continue to improve each year, which allowed me to participate in other activities like Special Olympics. Right now I am able to ride at Willow Creek for a few months out of the year due to cold weather. Sometimes when I don't ride for several months during the winter, I have difficulty remembering the basics. I hope someday soon they will be able to build an indoor area so I can ride every week. This would make a huge difference in my world.

And from Ashley's Mom...Ashley's experience at Willow Creek Ranch has been better than we could ever imagine. Her fear of heights used to require her even to have assistance walking down our stairs at home. Another challenge of Ashley's is social interaction. These issues have a significant impact on her daily life in school and in public. It is truly amazing to us that Ashley is now able to manage the height of the horse without any difficulty, has increased confidence and self-esteem, and even initiates conversations with others.

I cannot say enough about the volunteers at Willow Creek Ranch. They have established an environment that is safe & loving which allows riders like Ashley to grow in so many ways.
