<u>Our current fundraising needs</u> are to raise funds to purchase a few new saddles for our hard-working horses. Many of our current saddles have been with us for 15 or more years and were donated or purchased used. Saddle material breaks down over time. Leather stretches, the cushioning and lining degrades and compacts, and they just become uncomfortable for our horses. Please help us provide a good riding experience for our horses and our riders. Between our Giving Tuesday Facebook request and donors that sent checks, we have raised a bit more than \$2,750 of our \$4,500 goal.
